JUDGMENT

Entered: September 24, 2026

These two appeals are from a judgment that entered in the District Court for the District of Rhode Island. The appeals are hereby consolidated. One group of Plaintiff-Appellees has filed an "Emergency Motion for Summary Vacatur and Remand," and the other group of Plaintiff-Appellees has joined in the Emergency Motion's requests. Defendant-Appellants filed an opposition. We take Defendant-Appellants' main basis for objection to be that summary vacatur and remand would provide insufficient future assurances that Plaintiff-Appellees will not again bring the claim that we found unlikely to succeed on the merits.

We address the Emergency Motion as follows. We construe Plaintiff-Appellees by requesting vacatur and remand to have abandoned and formally waived any claim that the challenged actions in this case were contrary to law because of a failure to undertake any statutory notice-and-comment requirements. This claim being the one endorsed by the district court as the legal basis for the judgment, we conclude that there is no longer any live dispute between the parties as to the appeal. Accordingly, vacatur and remand is appropriate, with the understanding that Plaintiff-Appellees are estopped from raising their notice-and-comment claim again in this litigation, and with the expectation that any eventual judgment at the district court will dismiss that claim with prejudice to future reassertion.

The judgment of the district court is hereby **VACATED** and these appeals are **REMANDED** to the district court for further proceedings.
