

**TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF 20-S 2273,
RELATING TO RHODE ISLAND CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND
EXPENDITURE REPORTING
February 11, 2020**

The ACLU of Rhode Island strongly supports this bill, which would allow candidates to use campaign funds for childcare expenses associated with running for office.

Presently, candidates for office can use their campaign funds for such things as travel, food and beverages, and even purchases of graduation and marriage gifts. Under the circumstances, it is impossible to make a fair or legitimate argument against including childcare expenses in that list. The balancing of family and politics is always difficult, but it is a particularly significant burden on women candidates.

Federal campaign finance rulings recognize the importance of this and authorize the use of campaign funds to pay for candidates' childcare, and it is time that Rhode Island did too. As a matter of fundamental fairness, the ACLU urges approval of this proposal.
