TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF 23-H 5770, JOINT RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND PUBLISH AND SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS A PROPOSITION OF AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION – OF SUFFRAGE March 14, 2023

The ACLU of RI supports this proposed constitutional amendment, which would eliminate the state Constitution's onerous and archaic provision that bars individuals from voting in an election (except for President) unless they have registered to vote at least 30 days in advance. In this day and age, a 30-day registration window is simply an unnecessary and significant barrier to voting opportunities.

As an organization committed to ensuring that all qualified individuals have expansive, appropriate, and equitable opportunities for participation in the franchise, we believe that this amendment would allow the state to both modernize the voting process and make it more convenient and accessible for Rhode Island residents. Even as Rhode Island maintains a 30-day registration time frame, over 20 states have same-day registration, including a majority of the New England states, demonstrating how archaic this constitutional provision is.

The modernization of Rhode Island's electoral process should include measures that maximize the ability for voter participation, and this amendment would allow this to happen. We therefore strongly support bringing it to the voters for their consideration.
